

PERMIT PARKING

Your community board encourages anyone having problems with parking to apply for Permit Parking.

We are encouraging this to try and discourage some potential development projects within Kingsland where we feel parking will be a problem if the projects go ahead (i.e. Kingsland school changing to Chinook Learning, or rezoning of Elbow Drive residences that will then not allow access to the lot from Elbow Drive and force cars to park on 7th Street).

The community association is not able to do this for you and so someone on each block has to apply for the paperwork, talk to all residents on their block, block determined by Parking authority, acquire 80% approval of everyone on the block and then submit the forms to the Parking Authority.

Following submission of completed forms it takes approx. 4 – 6 weeks to have the posts installed. Each resident then has to obtain their parking passes, 1 pass for each car registered to that address up to 2 cars and 2 visitor parking passes which is assigned to the house and stays with it even if you move.

Permit Parking Procedures:

The first thing you have to do is call 311, tell them you want them to send you the petition forms to apply for permit parking.

If they ask you if your community has been zoned for parking you can tell them that it has and that your zone is KK. They will then ask you what your address is. They will submit your application and someone will contact you.

You will be mailed the package and the package will tell you which houses you have to canvass to get the 80% endorsement from your block.

In the cover letter they will tell you where to mail the filled in forms to.

You have to ask all residents on your block to select the duration (days and hours) they wish to have the parking restrictions apply and take the majority number, there are three options.
